 - a. Station 41 on Pine Drive has a wildland team that specializes in service to unhydranted areas such as ours.
 - b. South Metro has an ISO rating of "1", which can help reduce home insurance premiums.
 - c. This summer, South Metro plans to offer "neighborhood assessment days" in which they will provide a home wildfire assessment to anyone who wants it in a given neighborhood.
 - d. She encouraged residents to sign up for CodeRed (reverse 911) on the Douglas County website.
